

1. (50%) Solve exercise 2.11 on p. 50 from Payne (the book is in the 501/502 reference pack. The exercise wants you to construct a “position-class diagram”. Read the chapter till the end of the section “position-class diagrams”, and you will find what it is. This will also be a review of most of the things we covered in the last class.
2. (50%) Give the allomorphs of the second person agreement marker in Turkish. Is number separable from person as a morpheme? If so list its allomorphs as well. Think as many environments as you can, try not to miss any allomorphs.

If you think you do not know enough about person agreement to answer this question, consult Tallerman, Payne or any other source.

If your native language is not Turkish and you think this would be disadvantageous, do the exercise in your native language on a comparable morpheme.
